### **Board Report**

#### HALF YEARLY RESULT

We have had a very good first half of the financial year recording a profit of \$107,866 against our budget of \$68,368. Again, please remember these profit figures are not audited.

#### AREA BETWEEN GREENS B & C

We have now finalised the structure between B & C that will replace the present one. Due to the cost being over \$50,000 a General Meeting will be held on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2020@ 7.30pm for the members to approve or disapprove with this structure. All components of the present structure, except the small round posts in the middle, will be used in other sections to provide shade in these sections.

#### **REPLACEMENT LIGHTING FOR GREENS**

The original cost of this was approximately \$15,000 which, after the contractor said he made a mistake, was increased to just under \$50,000. After further discussions this has now been reduced to \$35,000. The Board will be discussing at our next Board meeting if this expenditure is justified for the benefits, if any, the Club would receive by replacing the lights at this cost.

#### CAPITAL EXPENDITURE

Major items that have been replaced at the Club are –

- Air-conditioning cassette in the gaming room;
- New ice machine;

- Replacement seating on Green A, which the Board thinks is very good and well done to Peter Brock;
- Two new gaming machines.

#### **GOVERNMENT GRANTS**

These grants are very important for the Club. They are for capital structures and bowls equipment. The Board is seeking members who would be willing to form a Grants Committee. This would involve the committee to continually be aware of any grants being given out by State or Federal Governments and filling in the paperwork to apply for these grants. #### **AFFILIATION FEES WITH BOWLS VICTORIA**

Wendy and I had a discussion with the management of Bowls Victoria putting forward our case for a refund as we were being overcharged on the system they use. This did not appear successful but in late December a refund payment of \$3,189 was received. The way they charge Affiliation fees will be changed next year.

#### WALL ART PROJECT

Rendering of the north brick wall is about to be done and this will be followed by the art work which was agreed to at the October AGM.
